

## The Two-Headed Hydra That Is The Novus Ordo

One of the most haunting lines in Holy Scripture from the blessed mouth of our Lord is when He asks out loud, “But yet the Son of man, when He cometh, shall he find, think you, faith on earth?”. You would think that this declaration of our Lord would implant in the minds and hearts of Christians the desire to be vigilant and make sure that one is holding to the faith of which has been revealed and given, of which generation upon generation of the faithful held unchanged from the time of our Lord. But, alas, we see how easily man has clamored after all sorts of new beliefs, new ways without seemingly having no problem with rejecting the old for the new novelty of the moment. Man’s heart and mind can be quite fickle. But to stray from the unchangeable doctrines and ways of our Lord and His Church always results in chaos, in confusion and in the destruction of faith and morals. To those that engage in and perpetuate this destruction are not sons of God, but sons of the Devil. “By their fruits you shall know them,” says our Lord again in Scripture. Our Lord did not say that by their intentions, by seeing their hearts and desires you will know them, because that is our Lord’s realm. He said that for us, we will see those with God and those against God by their fruits, by their actions, by what they say and do or don’t do. We have a tendency as Catholics today, to impute to others and imply that they are of good will, which may or not be true, that they have good intentions (although this can be virtuous at times) in order to absolve them of their culpability. We fail to recognize the reality that there are two ways, “He that is not with me, is against me,” says our Lord. Today we see the obvious machinations of the haters of God, like Francis and his minions and all those overt and obvious modernists of the past. But we fail at times to see that it is a two headed hydra that has set itself upon the world with the same intent to destroy souls. The two heads have different appearances but the fruits are the same. The one head is easy to see, but the other head is more subtle, albeit in reality, a much more damaging bite.

Those who are “conservative” in the Novus Ordo, and those of the SSPX, all those in the indults and all the recognize and resisters are always in a state of agitation, a state of internal cringing as a result of whatever is said by whom they claim to be a Pope and those whom they claim to be in authority continue to destroy any vestiges of Catholicism. But when it seems as though it is beginning to be too much for them to bear, out of the ashes comes forth a savior to anesthetize their agitation, much like a shot of a drug for a junkie does. The destruction of the Faith, the doctrines and dogmas, the necessary attributes of indefectibility of the Church, Infallibility, the Papacy, obedience; all are being either thrown on the garbage heap or changed in meaning to be a new monster which is foreign to what our Lord and His Church has always taught. Don’t be fooled by wolves in sheep’s clothing. Recognize the two heads of the hydra of the Novus Ordo to not be taken in and cling fast to what has always been and will always be, and those words of our Lord of finding faith on earth will happily apply to you as well as He will see you as part of the faithful sons of God.
